Around **133,000 new jobs** will be needed in **Food Manufacturing** between 2014 and 2024 across the UK, more than any other manufacturing sector.

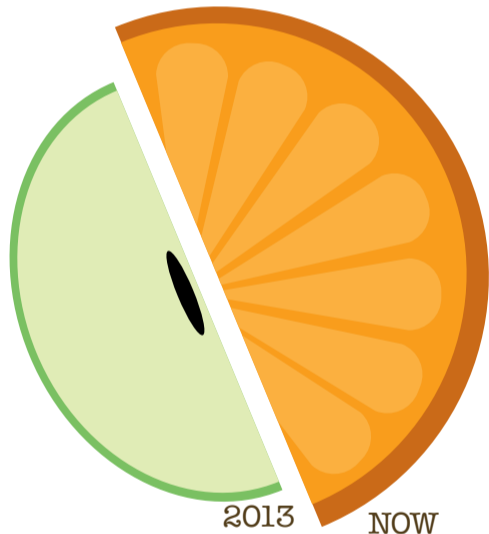

Food Products making up **66%**

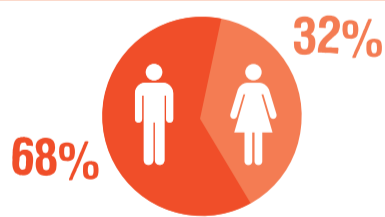
Cereals, Meat & Dairy make up **40%** of the exports from the UK Food sector.

The average salary is **£25,812** in the food sector
£38,202 in the beverages sector.

This compares to an average of **£32,047** in the wider UK manufacturing sector.

The average salary is rising by **3.3%** in the Food sector & **0.3%** in the beverage sector

89% of people in the food & drink sector are employed on a full time basis, compared to **11%** who are part time.



The UK food & drink manufacturing sector employs around **418,000 people**

Around **68%** of people working in the sector are men and **32%** are women.

Only **22%** of workers across the wider manufacturing sector are women.

There are around **9,460** enterprises in the sector.

This is around **7%** of the UK's manufacturing sector.
