

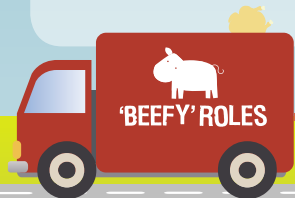
DID YOU KNOW?
